Dear Supervisor Kurtz,

I am writing in regards to a resolution passed by the members of the Waterford Citizens' Association to have a stop sign installed in front of the Post Office in Waterford. The sign would be for cars coming up Main Street from Milltown Road. Currently five roads intersect in the center of town, and all have stop signs except at this one location.

Safety is our concern. Cars come up Main Street and, without slowing down, turn the corner onto Second Street. With the entire village coming to the Post Office every day, with Main Street now having new families with children, and with the rapid growth of traffic from new homes being built north of the village, the time has come to allow pedestrians to walk at this main intersection without having to be on the lookout for cars whose drivers are focusing on getting through town as fast as possible without focusing on the pedestrian traffic.
