Old business

Street lights: Ed Lehmann noted that the WCA pays part of the electricity costs of the village street lights as the result of Waterford requesting to be part of a rural street light program years ago. Under this Loudoun County program, the County took over the maintenance of the street lights and paid part of the electricity costs. Paul Rose commented that because we paid part of the bill, the WCA was able to stop the installation of the orange vapor lights.

New Business

A report on Simms house was given by Laura Shaw. The HDRC deferred a vote because the plans for the addition were not detailed enough.

Jim Waggoner the WCA Treasurer noted that members had contributed an additional \$2000 for the July 4th activities when paying their dues.

Revised Comprehensive Plan: Kathleen Hughes encouraged everyone to email the Board of Supervisors about their views on the Board's changes to the Plan. She then reviewed some the groups concerned about fighting to maintain the Plan as it was passed by the previous Board.

The meeting was formally adjourned at 8:15.
